Icnos X informs you about its Privacy Policy regarding the treatment and protection of personal data of users and customers that may be collected by browsing or contracting services through the website www.icnosx.com.

The data provided will be kept as long as the commercial relationship is maintained or for the time necessary to comply with legal obligations and meet the possible responsibilities that may arise from fulfilling the purpose for which the data were collected. The data will not be transferred to third parties except in cases where there is a legal obligation. Likewise, and especially if you consider that you have not obtained full satisfaction in the exercise of your rights, you may file a complaint with the

national control authority by addressing the Spanish Data Protection Agency, 6 Jorge Juan Street, 6 - 28001 Madrid.

Likewise, we request your authorization before sending us your data to offer you products and services related to those hired and to retain you as a customer.

In this sense, the Holder guarantees compliance with current regulations on the protection of personal data, reflected in Organic Law 3/2018, of December 5, Protection of Personal Data and Guarantee of Digital Rights (LOPD GDD). It also complies with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons (GDPR).

The use of the website implies acceptance of this Privacy Policy, as well as the conditions included in the Legal Notice.

Principles applied in data processing

In the processing of your personal data, the Holder will apply the following principles that conform to the requirements of the new European data protection regulation:

- Principle of legality, loyalty and transparency: The Holder will always require the consent for the processing of your personal data that may be for one or several specific purposes on which he will previously inform you with absolute transparency.
- Principle of data minimization: The Holder will request only the data strictly necessary for the purpose or the purposes that request them.
- Principle of limitation of the storage period: The data will be kept for the time strictly necessary for the purpose or purposes of the treatment.

The Holder will inform you of the corresponding conservation period according to the purpose. In the case of subscriptions, the Holder will periodically review the lists and delete those inactive records for a considerable time.

- Principle of integrity and confidentiality: Your data will be treated in such a way that your security, confidentiality and integrity are guaranteed.

You should know that the Owner takes the necessary precautions to prevent unauthorized access or improper use of their users' data by third parties.

Obtaining personal data

To navigate through www.icnosx.com it is not necessary to provide any personal information. The cases in which you do provide your personal data are the following:

Your rights

The Holder informs you that about your personal data you have the right to:

- Request access to stored data.
- Request a rectification or cancellation.
- Request the limitation of your treatment.
- Oppose the treatment.
- Request the portability of your data.

The exercise of these rights is personal and therefore must be exercised directly by the interested party, requesting it directly from the Holder, which means that any client, subscriber or collaborator who has provided their data at any time can contact the Holder and request information on data that you have stored and how you have obtained them, request the rectification of them, request the portability of your personal data, oppose the processing, limit their use or request the cancellation of that data in the Holder's files.

You have the right to effective judicial protection and to file a claim with the control authority, in this case, the Spanish Agency for Data Protection, if you consider that the processing of personal data that concerns you violates the Regulation.

Purpose of the processing of personal data

This information may include personal data such as your IP address, first and last name, physical address, email address, telephone number, and other information.
